## CLASSES OF MEMBERSHIP

According to our By-Laws, the Association shall be divided into nine classes of membership

1. **Plant Mix Membership**

Plant Mix membership shall be open to those entities who own, lease or operate HMA plants and are engaged in the production of HMA.

2. **Regular Membership**

Regular membership shall be open to those entities engaged in paving with HMA or applying seal coats, slurry coats or similar surface treatments.

3. **Asphalt Cement Supplier Membership**

Asphalt Supplier Membership shall be open to those entities engaged in supplying asphalt cement for use in HMA.

4. **Emulsion Supplier Membership**

Emulsion supplier membership shall be open to those entities supplying asphalt emulsions.

5. **Major Supplier Membership**

Major Manufacturer Membership shall be open to those entities manufacturing materials or equipment used by a large number of Plant Mix Members

6. **Associate Member**

Associate Membership shall be open to those entities providing services, supplies, materials or equipment to Plant Mix Members.

7. **Consulting Engineer Membership**

Consulting Engineer Membership shall be open to those entities providing consulting engineer services related to the transportation industry.

8. **Life Membership**

Life Membership shall be open to individuals who have contributed outstanding service to the Association and are no longer active in the HMA industry in Illinois.

9. **Honorary Membership**

Honorary membership shall be open to individuals who having never been a member of the Association, made significant contributions to the advancement of the HMA industry in Illinois

**ILLINOIS ASPHALT PAVEMENT ASSOCIATION  
FEE SCHEDULE FOR 2010  
EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2009**

**I. PLANT MIX MEMBERS**

- A. The annual dues for each Plant Mix Member are \$600/per plant, \$1,250 minimum. Principals who own two or more companies and who are either full partners, chairman of the board, president, or substantial owner of another company must pay the dues of \$600/plant for all plants for EACH company.
- B. In addition to the annual dues: Plant Mix Members will be assessed 2.6 cents (\$0.026) for every ton of HMA produced (both governmental and private). Principals who own two or more companies and who are either full partners, chairman of the board, president, or substantial owner of another company must pay assessments on the combined tonnage from all plants. Plant Mix members will be on an honor system to report their tonnage on a quarterly form mailed from the IAPA office.

Example 1: If a member has one plant & produced 80,000 tons, he would pay:

Dues	\$ 1,250
80,000 tons	<u>2,080</u>
	\$ 3,330

Example 2: If a member has four plants and produced 460,000 tons, he would pay:

Dues	\$ 2,400
460,000 tons	<u>11,960</u>
	\$14,360

Example 3: If a member has interest in three different companies running ten plants with a total annual production of 1,500,000 tons, he would pay:
